# **INTRODUCTION:**

## **HOW DID THIS COME ABOUT?**

In the fall of 2012 Ariel Williams was reviewing devotional material samples for the upcoming Advent season. Nothing really fit the needs of her ministry context, so she thought “What the heck... I’ll write my own and see how that goes.” (Anyone who knows her knows that “heck” was really a completely different 4-letter-word.) One of the samples was based on the concept of texting, however it didn’t ACTUALLY include anything for youth to text. It was just hypothetical-in-your-head-pretend-texting.

Seeing how actual texting (and still is) the best way for her to contact her youth, she decided to play with the idea of creating a daily textable scripture devotion. It also occurred to her that if you can text it, you can tweet it, so the challenge became choosing a verse from the daily lectionary text for that day in 140 characters or less. Once the devotion for Advent Year C was complete she posted in several Facebook Groups that she had created this resource and would be happy to share with anyone interested. The response was OVERWHELMINGLY positive!

One of the respondents was Rachel Slough. Ariel and Rachel quickly formed a long distance friendship, eventually meeting in person at the 2013 ELCA Youth Ministry Network Extravaganza. Given the incredibly positive response to the 2012 devotional they were eager to take this project, in the wise words of Buzz Lightyear, “to infinity and beyond!” Rachel asked her friend Meredith McGrath to join and a collaboration was born.

## **WHY SOCIAL MEDIA MINISTRY?**

In May of 2013, 554,750,000 used twitter (<http://www.statisticbrain.com/twitter-statistics/>), and 1 in 4 teenagers use it on a daily basis, a number that is projected to increase (<http://www.pewinternet.org/Reports/2013/Teens-Social-Media-And-Privacy/Main-Report/Part-1.aspx>). Twitter can be used from phones via text messages (thereby not limiting to smartphones) and linked with Facebook or other social media platforms. It offers concise summaries and a chance to connect with other people and topics of interest. In addition more and more social media platforms are released each day. Youth are using Facebook, Twitter, Vine, Snapchat, Instagram, the list goes on and on! In short, social media is another increasingly important venue to preach the Gospel.

Statistical support aside, Ariel, Rachel, and Meredith wanted a way to briefly connect with their youth, encouraging them to know that being a Christian goes beyond Sunday mornings. WE wanted a way to help them prepare for Advent in a way that’s meaningful to them. We also recognized that these devotions can be helpful for a wider audience.

## **HOW DO I USE THIS?**

All three authors work in very different ministry settings, and we trust that each of you also have ministry needs that are unique to your own context. Our hope is that this resource is one that you can personalize. Here are ways that we have used this scripture resource and other possibilities that we hope to implement in the coming months and years. We welcome your suggestions too and hope you will contact us as you play with these ideas. As we continue this project we will share your words and add to the collective wisdom, celebrating that we are a community in Christ and a source of knowledge and strength together.

Some ideas to start your thinking:

- Send out daily text messages or tweets with the passage of the day OR follow Ariel on Twitter (@sassyariel80) and retweet the devo of the day. Post them on Facebook, send them out in your congregational newsletter, in the weekly bulletin, in any communication venues that work in your context.
- The images included can be tweeted, pinned to Pinterest, posted to Facebook, and shared via Instagram.
- Share the YouTube links via Facebook or Twitter.
- Invite congregation members to tweet responses and thoughts to the scripture.
- Provide Post-it notepads to youth the week before you begin sending the texts. Encourage them to write the hashtag on the post-it and then place it on a wall or surface in their room the entire Advent Season. Each day as they add to their Scriptural Hashtag Wall, they will be visually reminded of the importance of the Advent Season.
- Integrate tweeting into worship. For example, during midweek Lenten services 2012, Rachel's congregation had designated times when tweeted responses and questions were requested. They were then posted on a screen for pastors to address. Those without devices could write responses and one of several designated "tweeters" would post them.
- If you use worship notes in confirmation, include an opportunity for the confirmand to summarize the sermon or a verse into 140 characters and have them tweet it. Rachel has tried this with her confirmation students (6th-8th grade students) and found them quite responsive and enthusiastic

### **Rachel Slough:**


